According to these passages what do we need to be on guard against? Why is being on guard helpful in our pursuit to stand firm?

*Read Matthew 10:16-28*

What does Jesus mean about the one who can kill the body and the one who can kill the soul?

How does fearing the right person give us the courage to stand firm even in the face of adversity and pain?
