### Read: Romans 6:1-2

What do you think Paul means when he is pondering whether or not grace may increase? Are there times when you have wondered if God's grace was dependent upon your future "performance"? How did that make you feel? Was it helpful or harmful?

### Read: Ephesians 2:8-9 and James 2:17-18

How do we reconcile the fact that the passage in Ephesians clearly says we are saved by grace, while the passage in James clearly says faith without deeds [works] is dead?

When Dallas Willard speaks of the "Gospel of Sin Management", how does that resonate with you? Can you think of a time when the Gospel became a "Do" or "Don't" list? How did that make you feel? Was it helpful or harmful? Is there a time where you found yourself sharing "Sin Management" expectations with someone?

Can you think of a time where you didn't see God's presence in a particular moment, not because He wasn't there, but because you were focused on something else? How might that change the way you see God today? What might that change the way you see God in the future?
