What is the difference between sight and vision?

How did your lack of vision impact your actions and attitude?

How would having vision have changed your circumstances or situation?

### **Read: 2 Kings 6:8-10**

The Spirit of God allowed Elisha to have the ability to see where the King of Aram was going to be before he was there. The King of Israel trusted and followed the vision of Elisha rather than human wisdom and understanding.

In what ways does God ask us to trust and follow what He knows and can see rather than our human intuition and understanding?

### **Read: 2 Kings 6:11-19**

Elisha's servant believed that he and Elisha were surrounded and outnumbered by the enemy, but he couldn't yet see they were not alone.

In what area of your life do you feel outnumbered, surrounded and alone?

In what area of your life do you need God to open your eyes so you can see that you are not alone?

Spend some time praying for God to open your eyes to help you see what He sees in those areas of your life where you feel outnumbered, out of options and out of your league.
